

Major at Nagoya University: Law

Period of study: Fall semester – October 1st – February 8th

Spring semester – April 11th – August 8th (dates may vary, student has to arrive two weeks prior to semester for orientation)

Nomination deadline: October 1st, March 1st (Selection at home University 1 month prior to nomination)

Deadlines for document selection at Home University: 2 weeks before nomination (September 14th for spring semester and February 14th for fall semester)

Eligibility: GPA 3,0 and more, TOEFL (iBT) 79; IELTS overall band score 6,0; TOEIC 780; CEFR band B2; CET — 6 score of 450 or Japanese Lvl N1 or JLPT.

Availability: per **one** student for semester

Required documents for Home University selection: Application form, 2 signed recommendation letters from teaching staff in free form, Individual study plan (address to your adviser), official transcript in English, confirmation from parents, citizens application. After student`s candidacy is approved he/she has to provide Learning agreement, Health certificate 082 and invitation letter from accepting University.

Application to NUPACE:

1) study plan of 400 words with the names of courses (courses are available here:

2) Official Transcript in English

3) Certificate of enrolment in English (order from I/OH)

4) Internationally recognized English/Japanese proficiency test

Study opportunities: tuition fee is waived for Host University, application to JASSO student exchange support program (scholarship for short-term study in Japan) a monthly stipend of 80 000 JPY per month, all expences have to be covered by student and tuition fee should be paid to Home University.

Approximate expenditures:

Rent/Utilities	25 000 — 40 000 JPY per month
Food	30 000 JPY per month
Personal expences	30 000 JPY per month

For fall semester:

Closing date for applications (March, 15) — 1st screening examination by university committee (late April) — Successful application sent to Schools for 2nd screening (early May) — Notification of application results by email (late May) — Despatch of admission letters (early August) — Notification of Jasso scholarship results (late August) — Students arrival at Nagoya University (late September)

For spring semester:

Closing date for applications (October, 15) — 1st screening examination by university committee (mid-December) — Successful application sent to Schools for 2nd screening (late December) — Notification of application results by email (mid-January next year) — Despatch of admission letters (early March) — Notification of Jasso scholarship results (late March) — Students arrival at Nagoya University (early April).
